A reading streak is when you read every day. Read for at least 10 minutes.

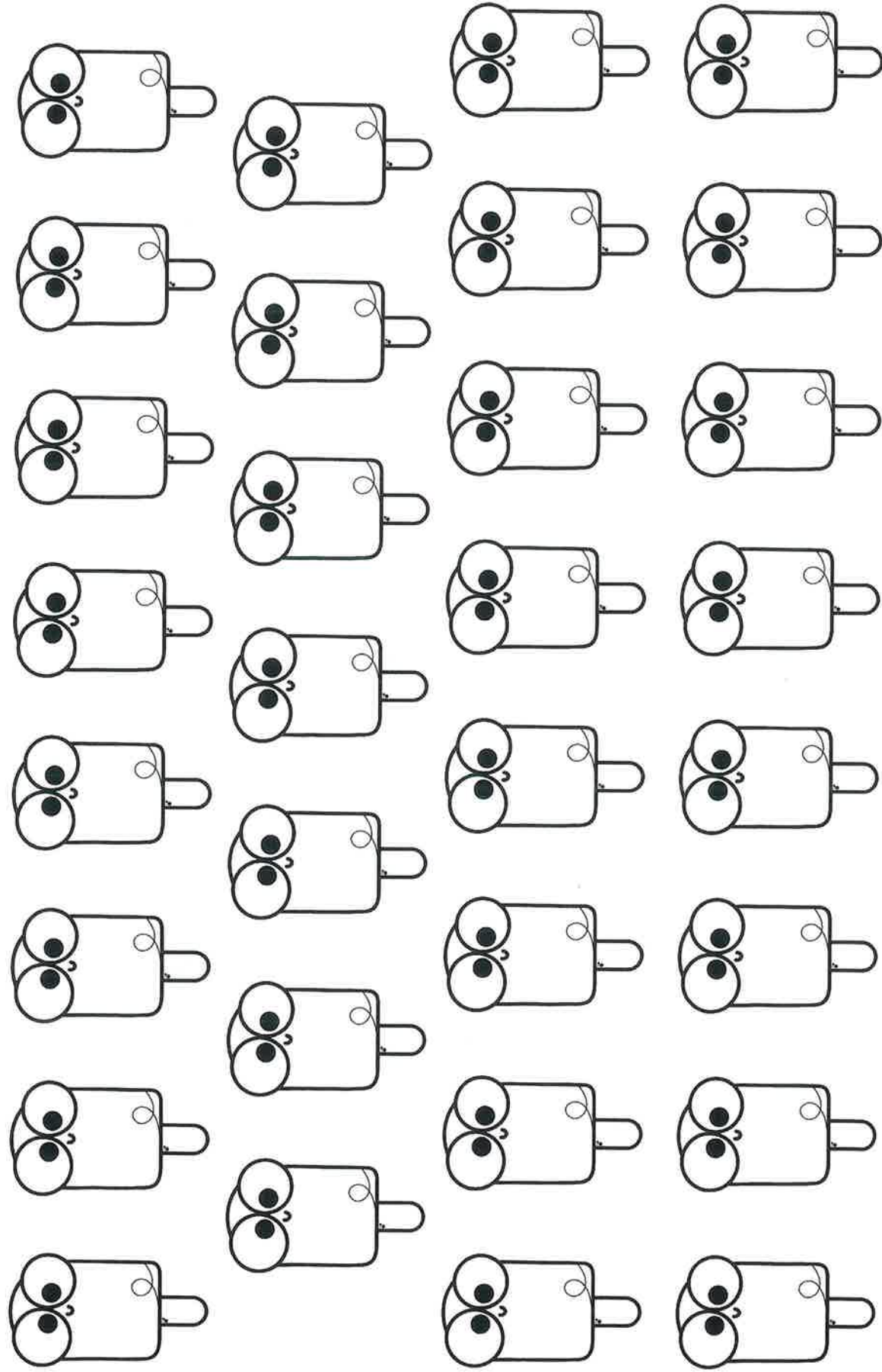
